

# swak curtains



Cut yarn in 1 yard (36") lengths. You will want to have a wide assortment of textures, colors, and thicknesses. Cut all yarns before beginning.

Hold 2-4 strands of mixed yarns together. The number of strands will depend on the thickness of the yarns. The thicker the yarns, the fewer strands needed.

Fold strands in half forming a loop at the fold. Pull cut ends through loop, and tighten around curtain rod.

You are basically "fringing" a curtain rod. Try to keep each bundle similar in size, and make sure the knot formed by the fringe is facing the same direction.

We thought they looked best untrimmed, except for shortening a few really long strands.
