

The Kiss

This whimsical lip shaped pillow makes a great gift for a sweetheart and will spice up any decor.



Sealed with a Kiss

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Supplies & Such

Yarn

Rowan Cork

50gm skeins, 120 yds (110m)

3 skeins #049 Ruby Red (MC)

1 skein #048 Lipstick Pink (CC)

Needles & Things

- Size 8 (5.0mm) or size to get gauge
- Tapestry Needle
- Polyester filling

Gauge

20 stitches x 28 rows = 4" in stockinette stitch

Note: Gauge must be worked tightly. A light bulky yarn was used, worked at a much tighter gauge than normal.

Finished Size

- Height 11"
- Width 24"

Abbreviations

CC	Contrasting Color
CO	Cast On
beg	Beginning
BO	Bind Off
K	Knit
K2tog	Knit 2 sts together
MC	Main Color
P	Purl
rem	Remain
RSR	Right Side Row
SSK	Slip 2 sts knitwise, one a time to right hand needle. Insert left needle into front of these 2 sts from left to right, and knit these 2 sts together.
st(s)	stitch(es)
Stockinette	
Stitch (st st)	Row 1 (RSR): Knit Row 2 (WSR): Purl
WSR	Wrong Side Row

Instructions

Pillow (Make 2)

With MC, CO 30 sts

Work in st st throughout, beginning with a WSR.

Purl one row

CO 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows (38 sts)

CO 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows (44 sts)

CO 2 sts at beg of every row until 108 sts

Work 4 rows

BO 2 sts at beg of every row until 80 sts

BO 2 sts, K 36, BO center 2 sts, K to end (37 sts on right, 39 sts on left)

Work left side:

Row 1 (WSR): BO 2 sts at beg of row, P to end

Row 2 (RSR): SSK, K to end

repeat these 2 rows until 21 sts remain

BO 2 sts at beg of every row until 11 sts remain

BO 3 sts at beg of next row (8 sts)

BO remaining 8 sts

Work right side:

Join yarn at middle of lip, purl across.

Row 1 (RSR): BO 2 sts at beg of row, K until 2 sts remain, K2tog

Row 2 (WSR): Purl

repeat these 2 rows until 19 sts remain

BO 2 sts at beg of every row until 13 sts remain

BO 3 sts at beg of row (10 sts)

BO 2 sts at beg of row (8 sts)

BO remaining 8 sts

Finishing

Seam front and back lips together, leaving bottom cast on edge open for stuffing.

Stuff lips, and close bottom seam.

With CC, back stitch across lips as shown in photo. Embroider a special message on the back to your

Since first publishing this pattern, Rowan Cork has been discontinued. We recommend using a light bulky yarn or even a worsted weight wool doubled.
